The Tri-Municipal Industrial Partnership is a collaboration between:

- Municipal District of Greenview
- County of Grande Prairie
- City of Grande Prairie

The partnership is working towards the development of a world-class heavy eco-industrial district in the north.

Located south of Grande Prairie in the MD of Greenview, the proposed industrial district is focused on attracting investment specific to heavy industrial uses associated with methane gas, urea fertilizer, and amine gas. The proposed location is already connected to transportation pathways and served by expanding rail, road, and pipeline construction.
